# Ambulance Network Coordinator (Substantive and Pool)

The Ambulance Network Coordinator distributes ambulance attendances in the Metro region to the hospital Emergency Departments. The ANC will base distribution decisions on the Department of Health (DoH) requirements, while also considering the condition of the patient and the status of individual Emergency Departments. The aim is to be pre-emptive and actively manage ambulance distribution to minimize impacts of ramping on St John Ambulance resources.

### **Prerequisites**

Qualified Country Support Officer Completed 200 shifts over a minimum of 12 months

Maintain individual 000 call performance at or above the Agency Cumulative Performance value for a period of 3 months
