



Paramedic 2024-2027 EBA Survey Results



Where do you usually work?



The above questions were combined to formulate the Paramedic Log of Claims for 2024-2027. The member responses were split into multiple categories. Those being

- 1. Allowances.
- 2. Rostering.
- 3. Policies/Clauses.
- 4. Breaks.
- 5. Leave.
- 6. Secondments.
- 7. Fatigue, and
- 8. Safety.

There were also items that could not be include in the Log of Claims, these were due to

- 1. the item was not wanted by most of the membership (i.e. a trade-off), or
- 2. they were not EBA related items.

Items that could potentially improve our working conditions, that were not EBA related have been moved to the Paramedic JCC for further discussions.
